

**South Segment: Carroll Canyon Road
Bridge Advisory**

Construction to begin on Carroll Canyon Road Bridge Over Interstate 15

Construction Activities:

Please be advised that in late February construction workers will place temporary concrete barriers along the middle of Carroll Canyon Road Bridge, which will temporarily eliminate two lanes and shift traffic to the north. One eastbound lane and one westbound lane will be open during construction. A left turn lane onto the northbound on-ramp and a left turn lane onto the southbound on-ramp will also be provided during construction. Northbound and southbound ramps will remain open during this phase of construction.

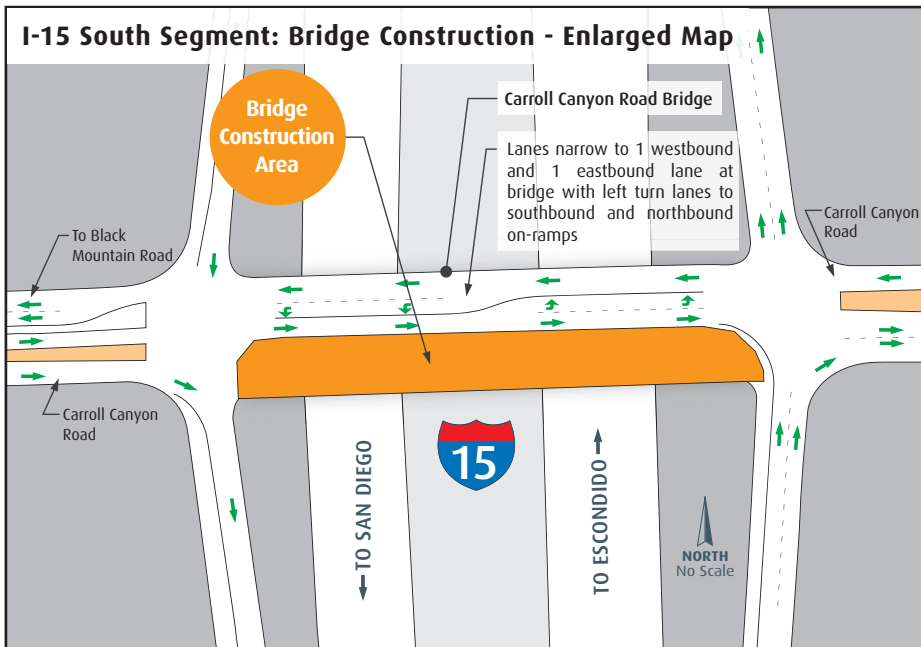
This traffic change is necessary to prepare for bridge demolition work, which will take place during the night and may cause noise. Demolition work must take place at night in order to close the I-15 with minimal disruptions to traffic.

Timeframe:

This phase of construction will begin in late February and last approximately one year. Bridge work will be completed in 2011. Once completed, the bridge will return to two lanes in each direction. This bridge construction is necessary to accommodate the expansion of the I-15 Express Lanes in the South Segment of the project area.

Funding:

The cost of the South Segment is approximately \$481 million. The total cost of the I-15 Express Lanes project is \$1.3 billion.



One eastbound lane and one westbound lane will remain open during this phase of construction. A left turn lane will be provided to access the I-15 northbound and southbound on-ramps from the Carroll Canyon Road Bridge.
