

Bike/Pedestrian Improvements



Overview

Linking local and regional bicycle and pedestrian trails to improve coastal access is a key component of the North Coast Corridor (NCC) Program. Build NCC includes projects aimed at improving east-west/north-south connectivity for people walking and biking in Solana Beach, Encinitas, and Carlsbad. These projects are part of a 40-year vision to improve the quality of life for residents, create a stronger local and regional economy for the future, and enhance the coastal environment.

Highlighted below are just a few of the bike and pedestrian improvements included under Build NCC. Improvements will be underway in 2016 and completed by 2020.

North Coast Bike Trail



A new separated bikeway on Manchester Avenue will connect the San Elijo Lagoon Visitor Center to the new Park & Ride/Multiuse Facility. A suspended pedestrian bridge will also be built underneath the San Elijo highway bridge to further increase north-south and east-west connectivity, and create more travel options. The North Coast Bike Trail will include new paths connecting Solana Beach to northern Encinitas.

Santa Fe Drive and Encinitas Boulevard Bike/Ped Improvements



Separated bike and pedestrian paths at the Interstate 5 interchange at Santa Fe Drive and Encinitas Boulevard will be constructed. These improvements will help improve east-west connectivity and safety for people walking and biking to nearby schools and activity centers.

Coastal Access Improvements



A pedestrian rail undercrossing at the southern end of the San Elijo Lagoon and an at-grade rail crossing at Chesterfield Drive will be built. These improvements will allow pedestrians to safely cross the Los Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN) rail line and increase coastal access in Encinitas.
