

Work Scheduled to Begin in October to Repair Slope at the Rancho Bernardo Transit Station

Temporary Closure of South Parking Lot During Repairs

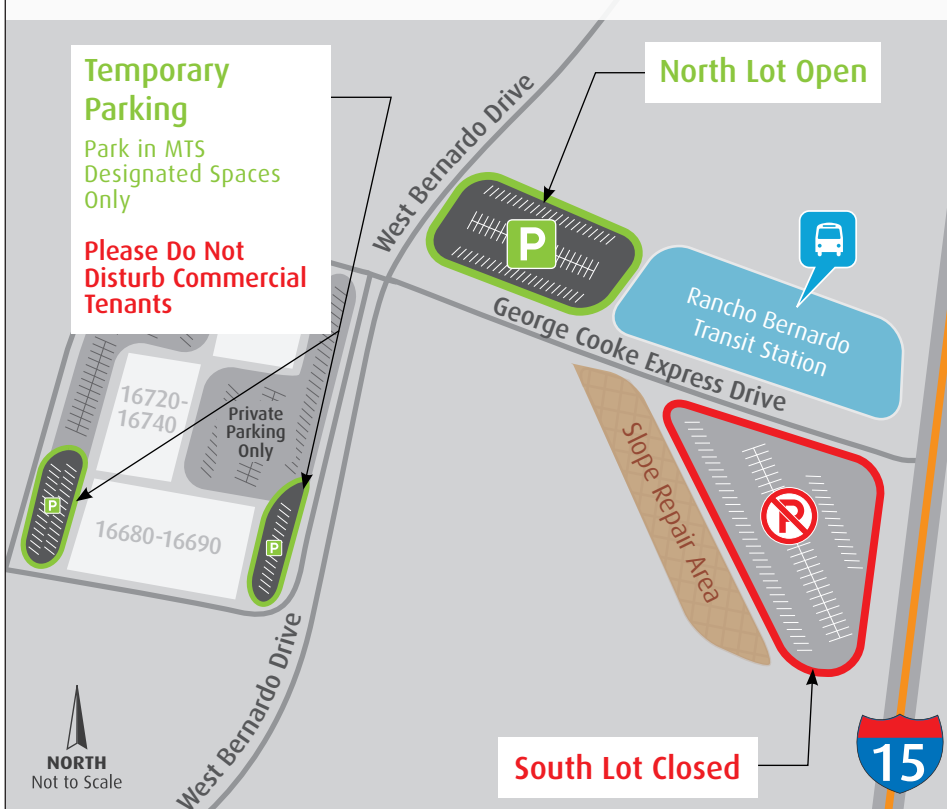
- ▶ On Monday, Oct. 3, crews will begin to fix a slope failure above the south parking lot of the Rancho Bernardo Transit Station. To complete the slope repair, the transit station's south parking lot will be temporarily closed. The work is expected to take two to three months.
- ▶ The station's **north parking lot will remain open** and temporary parking will also be available. Those spaces are in front and back of LBA/West Bernardo Business Park, 16680-16690 West Bernardo Drive. **Park in MTS designated spaces only and please do not disturb the commercial tenants.**
- ▶ Commuters are welcome to use the Sabre Springs/Peñasquitos Transit Station's Park & Ride where they can catch MTS Premium Express Bus Routes 820 and 860 to downtown San Diego.
- ▶ During the first several days of construction, commuters should consider arriving a few minutes earlier than normal to adjust to the parking changes.
- ▶ Thank you in advance for your patience during construction.
