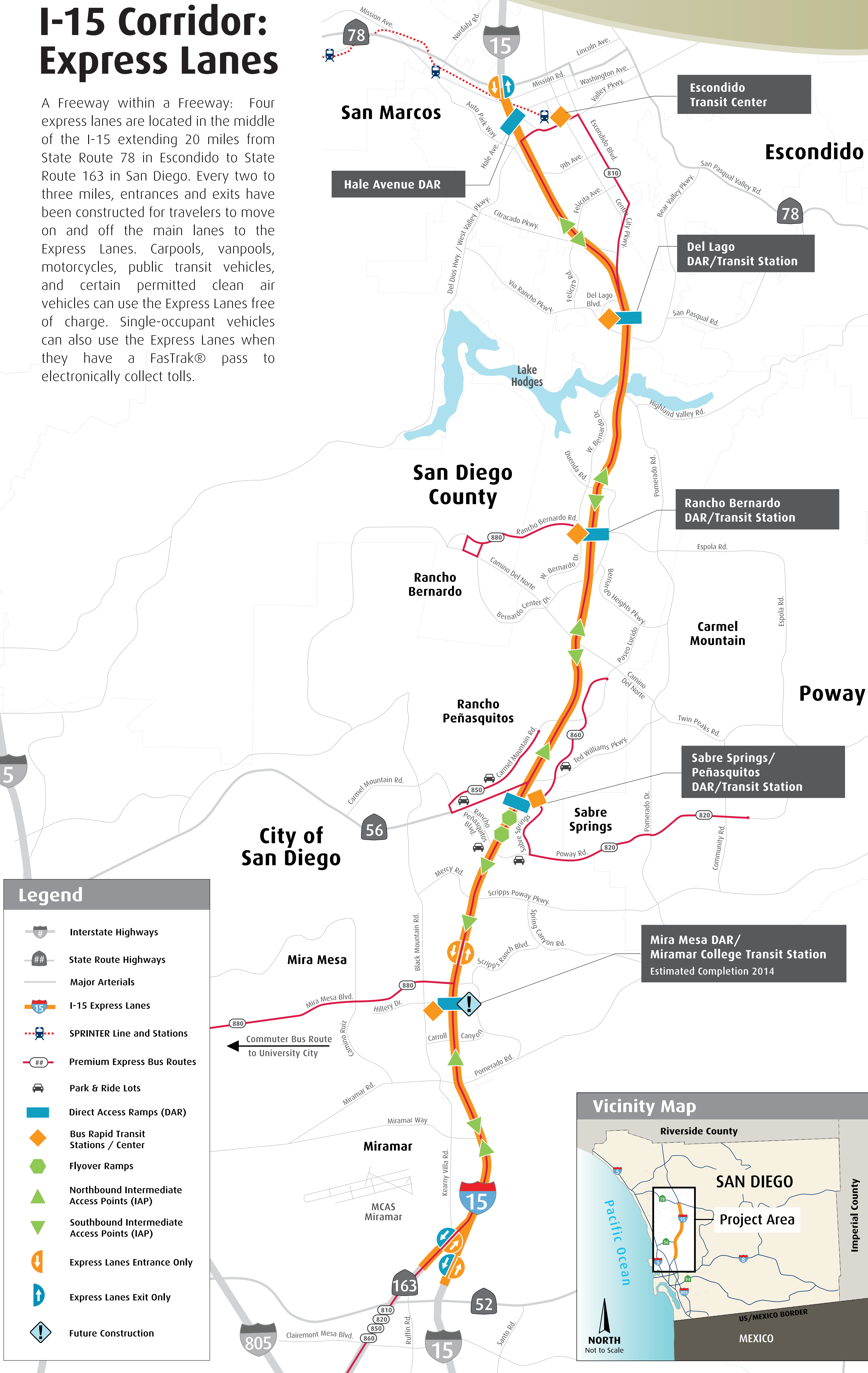


I-15 Corridor: Express Lanes

A Freeway within a Freeway: Four express lanes are located in the middle of the I-15 extending 20 miles from State Route 78 in Escondido to State Route 163 in San Diego. Every two to three miles, entrances and exits have been constructed for travelers to move on and off the main lanes to the Express Lanes. Carpools, vanpools, motorcycles, public transit vehicles, and certain permitted clean air vehicles can use the Express Lanes free of charge. Single-occupant vehicles can also use the Express Lanes when they have a FasTrak® pass to electronically collect tolls.
