Construction Advisory #8 Freeway Closure on SR 78 at Nordahl Road Week of July 30th

Please be advised that demolition work on the west side of the Nordahl Road bridge will begin the week of Monday, July 30, 2012 for five consecutive nights between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Additional road work will occur on the westbound SR 78 between Nordahl Road and Woodland Parkway/Barham Drive for one night during this week.

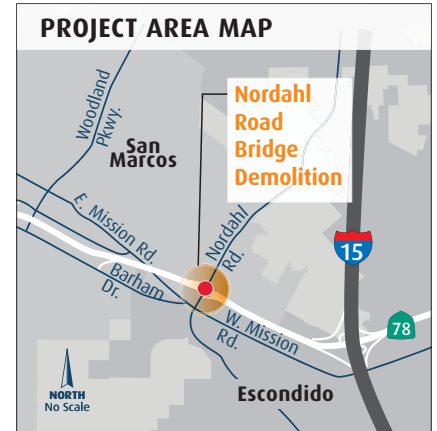
During these nighttime closures, motorists are urged to avoid the area if possible. Traffic delays at this location and intermittent road closures on Nordahl Road bridge's southbound lanes are expected during the demolition. The bridge's temporary pedestrian bridge will continue to remain open during the demolition. Also, signs will be in place to direct motorists through any closures on Nordahl Road and SR 78.

DETOUR 1A: Westbound SR 78 motorists will exit at the Nordahl Road off ramp and re-enter SR 78 at the Nordahl Road on ramp. [See Route Below](#)

DETOUR 1B: During one night this week, westbound SR 78 motorists will exit north on Nordahl Road, then west on Rock Springs Road, then south on Woodland Parkway on to the SR 78 west on ramp from Rancheros Drive. [See Route Below](#)

DETOUR 2: Eastbound SR 78 motorists will exit at the Nordahl Road off ramp and re-enter SR 78 at the Nordahl Road on ramp. [See Route Below](#)

The schedule for this freeway closure is subject to weather delays, as well as the availability of the heavy construction machinery that will be used to remove the west side of the bridge's structure. Residents and businesses in the area are also advised that this machinery will cause noise in the area during the demolition. The Nordahl Road bridge replacement project is scheduled to be completed in Fall 2012.
