## **Construction Advisory**

### Intermittent Overnight Closures Planned the Week of April 27 at I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange

Beginning Sunday, April 26, and throughout the week, the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Genesee Avenue northbound off-ramp and Roselle Street southbound on-ramp will be closed intermittently from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. due to construction. During this same period, there will be lane closures on northbound and southbound I-5. Overnight work also will continue on Genesee Avenue within project limits.

Monday or Tuesday night, April 27/28, closures on I-5 at the interchange will leave one lane open to traffic in both directions. Between approximately 11 p.m. and 1 a.m., California Highway Patrol officers will be present to direct traffic as construction crews move equipment across the median.

Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions.

Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Motorists are advised to plan their travel and avoid the area, if possible. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the interchange.

#### About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes to better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region. The project also will widen the on- and off-ramps to help improve traffic flow, add a northbound auxiliary lane on I-5 between Genesee Avenue and Roselle Street, and construct a new, separated bicycle/pedestrian path.

The I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
