Intermittent Overnight Lane Closures and Detours Planned This Week at I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange

Caltrans will begin night work this week on the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Genesee Avenue Interchange Project to place temporary concrete barriers and restripe highway lanes. Work will take place tonight, tomorrow and Sunday (March 18, 19, and 22) from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Today and Tomorrow: Intermittent closures of up to three lanes of northbound and southbound I-5 between Voigt Drive and Sorrento Valley Road. The southbound Roselle Street on-ramp and the I-5/Genesee Avenue on- and off-ramps also will be closed intermittently. Motorists will be detoured to nearby interchanges at La Jolla Village Drive or Roselle Street.

Sunday: Intermittent lane closures on northbound I-5 between Genesee Avenue and Roselle Street. Motorists travelling through the area can expect delays and are advised to avoid the area if possible.

Construction crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Motorists are urged to plan their travel and avoid the area, if possible. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes to better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region. The project also will widen the on- and off-ramps, add a northbound auxiliary lane on I-5 between Genesee Avenue and Roselle Street and construct a new, separated bicycle/pedestrian path.

The I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
