Intermittent Overnight Ramp Closures Planned Next Week at I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange

I-5/Genesee Avenue On- and Off-Ramps to be Reconfigured

Beginning Sunday night, March 29, and throughout the week, Caltrans will continue night work on the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Genesee Avenue Interchange.

There will be intermittent overnight closures of the I-5/Genesee Avenue on- and off-ramps, as well as work in the I-5 median.

IMPORTANT: Motorists can expect to see major changes to the I-5/ Genesee signalized intersections for all on- and off-ramps to Genesee Avenue. The separated "free right" turn lane on the existing ramps will no longer be accessible. Motorists will now approach the traffic signals, stop, and make a right turn when it is safe to do so. The separated "free right" turn lanes - that have allowed motorists to travel through interchanges without stopping at traffic signals - are being removed as part of a Caltrans statewide policy.

Construction crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Motorists are advised to plan their travel and avoid the area, if possible. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes to better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region. The project also will widen the on- and off-ramps to help improve traffic flow, add a northbound auxiliary lane on I-5 between Genesee Avenue and Roselle Street, and construct a new, separated bicycle/pedestrian path.

The I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
