


Between March and August 2020, Bike Volumes are up...

- Provide Transportation Options




Designing for People of All Ages and Abilities

- Traffic calming to reduce speeds
- Challenges in urban areas due to limited space and competing uses

 - Park Boulevard Bikeway(Upas Street to Village Place)




Washington Street & Bachman Place Bikeways

- Alignment (3.3 miles)
 - Washington Street
 - San Diego Avenue
 - Third Avenue
 - Bachman Place
 - Hotel Circle
 - Camino de la Reina
- CEQA Cleared in July 2016
- 95% Design Completed
- City Review 2022
- Construction Begins 2023








Washington Street Wall – Before



Washington Street Wall – Proposed




Washington Street Wall – Cross Section

- Spaced ~150' alongW Washington Street




Recent Progress
