Elevator Towers Forming



Construction crews work on forming the elevator tower south of University Avenue.

Motorists may notice a new structure in the median along State Route 15 (SR 15). Crews are forming the foundation for an elevator structure south of University Avenue. The elevator will allow passengers to travel between the freeway-level transit stations and the street level. Construction crews also have been working to remove and install overhead sign structures along the SR 15 median.

As the safety of motorists and workers is the highest priority, the majority of construction work takes place at night to minimize traffic impacts. Night work also allows construction vehicles to move safely in and out of construction zones. Crews will work to minimize noise and light impacts to the surrounding neighborhoods. Thank you for your patience during construction.

SR 15 Commuter Bikeway Update

Vegetation removal along the eastern shoulder of SR 15 has been completed to prepare for the [SR 15 Commuter Bikeway](#). Once the bikeway is built, the contractor will replace vegetation. Bikeway construction is expected to begin in March 2016. When completed, the bikeway will provide a safe and direct bike route connecting communities in the Mid-City area with the major retail, commercial, education, and entertainment destinations in the Mission Valley area.

Project Summary

The \$65 million project will build San Diego's first freeway-level *Rapid* transit stations along SR 15 at El Cajon Boulevard and University Avenue. New 2.5-mile transit-only lanes also will be constructed within the existing SR 15 median from just north of Interstate 805 to just south of Interstate 8. The SR 15 Mid-City Centerline *Rapid* Transit Stations Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
