Intermittent Overnight Closures Planned at I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange

IMPORTANT: On Thursday, June 18, crews will close three of four southbound Interstate 5 (I-5) lanes from the I-5/I-805 merge to Genesee Avenue from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Workers plan to close all southbound I-5 lanes from approximately 2–4 a.m. This closure is required to remove signage in preparation for the installation of falsework, which are temporary structures used to support the foundation of the new I-5/Genesee Avenue Bridge.

In addition, intermittent overnight closures from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. are expected at the I-5/Genesee Avenue northbound off-ramp for the next several months.

Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. Motorists are advised to plan their travel and avoid the area, if possible. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the interchange.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes to better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
