# **Construction to Begin This Month on Sorrento Valley Double Track Project**

### **PROJECT OVERVIEW:**

The Sorrento Valley Double Track project will help to improve the reliability and on-time performance of COASTER, Amtrak, and BNSF Railway services by removing a bottleneck along San Diego's coastal rail line and allowing passenger and freight trains to pass each other as they enter and leave the Sorrento Valley transit station. Project features include:

- Adding 1.1 miles of second track north of the transit station.
- Adding a new 81-space surface parking lot south of the transit station.
- Raising the railroad tracks above the flooding level of 50-year storm events.
- Replacing two aging wooden trestle bridges with new concrete structures.
- Installing drainage and embankment improvements.

### ABOUT THE LOSSAN RAIL CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT:

The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) is working in collaboration with the North County Transit District (NCTD) to plan, design, and construct approximately \$1 billion in improvements along the San Diego County section of the LOSSAN (Los Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo) coastal rail

### **Project Construction Schedule:**

February 2014 through late 2015 Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Because this is an active rail line with more than 50 trains per day, some of the construction must be conducted during off-peak hours on weekends and evenings. Construction crews will work to minimize noise and traffic impacts to nearby businesses. Please use extra caution when construction crews or vehicles are present.
