



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects.

Week of February 27, 2017

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect lane closures along Interstate 5 (I-5) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Birmingham Drive for approximately four weeks.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on northbound I-5.

RAIL

- Travelers should expect intermittent lane closures from approximately 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. along Chesterfield Drive between San Elijo Avenue and Highway 101 Monday, February 27, through Friday, March 3, as crews work to identify the location of important utilities within the work areas.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise, and travelers are encouraged to allow more time to reach their destination.
