



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects.

Week of July 17, 2017

HIGHWAY

- Motorists can expect the closure of the northbound I-5 off-ramp at Manchester Avenue from 3 a.m. Sunday, July 16, to 5 a.m. Monday, July 17.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent daytime and nighttime noise and lights, and motorists can expect to be detoured to Birmingham Drive, southbound I-5, and then to Manchester Avenue.
- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5 (I-5) Monday, July 17, through Friday, July 14, from 21 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Birmingham Drive.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on northbound and southbound I-5.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and traffic delays from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, July 17, through Friday, July 21, as crews work on a retaining wall and construct the new rail bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon.
- Motorists should expect daytime closures along San Elijo Avenue from Dublin Drive to Norfolk Drive as crews work to construct a new retaining wall.
