Overnight tonight through noon on Saturday, there will be intermittent lane closures on Interstate 5 (I-5) to allow crews to pour the concrete

deck of the new bridge.

During this same time, there also will be reduced lanes on Genesee Avenue, as well as a closure of the southbound off-ramp at the I-5/Genesee Avenue interchange.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained. Motorists are advised to avoid the area if possible and slow down during construction.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, new bicycle lanes and sidewalks, and better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.

The I-5/Genesee Avenue Interchange Project is expected to be completed in 2017.
