Drivers Should Plan for Traffic Delays This Afternoon on Eastbound Genesee Avenue

Motorists traveling eastbound on Genesee Avenue from North Torrey Pines Road to Interstate 5 (I-5) should expect traffic delays today due to interim lane restriping. As a result of the work, eastbound Genesee Avenue between Science Center Drive and I-5 has been temporarily reduced to two lanes.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area if possible. The restriping work is scheduled to be completed tonight. Eastbound Genesee Avenue will be restored to three lanes for the Tuesday commute. We appreciate your patience during construction.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, new bicycle lanes and sidewalks, and better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
