Planned Closures and Detours

The list below shows planned overnight closures and detours at the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Genesee Avenue Interchange. Closures and detours will occur intermittently between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Please note construction schedules are subject to change.

Overnight Closures and Detours for the Week of August 2, 2015

Sunday – Tuesday, August 2 – 4, approximately 11 p.m. – 5 a.m.

- **SOUTHBOUND I-5 DETOUR**
 - Exit southbound I-5 at Genesee Avenue.
 - Cross intersection.
 - Enter southbound I-5 on-ramp.

Motorists using the State Route (SR) 56 local bypass attempting to take southbound I-5 will be detoured to southbound I-805, then westbound SR 52. Motorists are advised to use southbound I-5 rather than the SR 56 local bypass to avoid an additional detour. Signs will be placed to alert motorists in advance.

Tuesday – Thursday, August 4 – 6, and Sunday, August 9, approximately 11 p.m. – 5 a.m.

- **NORTHBOUND I-5 DETOUR**
 - Exit northbound I-5 at Genesee Avenue.
 - Cross intersection.
 - Enter northbound I-5 on-ramp.

Northbound and southbound I-5 will not be closed concurrently.

Throughout the Week

- Intermittent lane closures on eastbound & westbound Genesee Avenue.
- Overnight closure of the eastbound on-ramp to northbound I-5 from La Jolla Village Drive.
- Overnight closure of the northbound off-ramp to Genesee Avenue (*only when northbound I-5 is open*).

Project limits include Science Center Drive to the main entrance at Scripps Hospital on Genesee Avenue, and Sorrento Valley Road to Voigt Drive on I-5.
