Intermittent Lane Closures on Genesee Avenue in April and May

Lane closures required for work on water lines

There will be reduced lanes on Genesee Avenue at Interstate 5 during several weekends in April and May while crews work to relocate utilities to accommodate the new freeway overpass.

Lane closures on Genesee Avenue will occur between Science Center Drive and Scripps Memorial Hospital. The traffic configuration may be different during each closure, depending on construction activities. Please note construction schedules are subject to change. Closures are weather permitting. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the interchange.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, new bicycle lanes and sidewalks, and better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
