Overnight Closures of I-5 at Genesee Avenue the Week of November 14

Closures

Motorists should be advised that intermittent overnight closures of all lanes on Interstate 5 (I-5) at Genesee Avenue will occur Monday - Thursday, November 14 – 17, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Please note, only one direction of the freeway will be closed at a time. These closures will allow the construction crews to install falsework, which are temporary wood forms used to support the foundation of the new I-5/Genesee Avenue Bridge.

Detours

During the partial closure of northbound I-5 lanes at La Jolla Village Drive overnight on November 14, motorists will be detoured to La Jolla Village Drive.

During partial freeway closures on November 15 - 17, motorists will be detoured at the interchange to the Genesee Avenue off-ramp and re-enter using the on-ramp across the intersection. Signs will be placed to alert motorists in advance.
