Upcoming Construction Along San Elijo Avenue

Work is scheduled to begin today on a temporary access road along San Elijo Avenue in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, just north of the lagoon, as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project.

Residents can expect to see construction vehicles entering and exiting the project area off San Elijo Avenue. Work will take place Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. During work hours, motorists can expect intermittent traffic control and delays along San Elijo Avenue between Dublin Drive and Manchester Avenue. We appreciate your patience during construction.

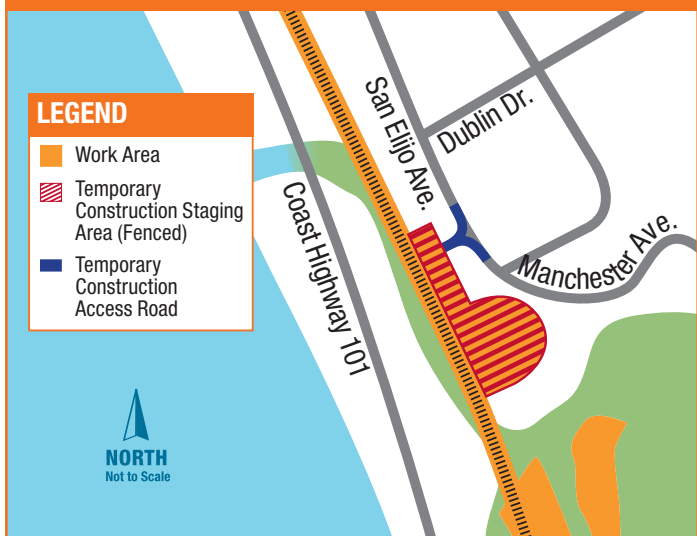

About the San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project

The San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project is a \$72.8 million project that will add 1.5 miles of new double track from Cardiff-by-the-Sea to the southern border of the San Elijo Lagoon, replace the wooden trestle bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon with a modern concrete bridge, construct a new pedestrian undercrossing at the south end of the lagoon, and improve the signal and grade crossing at Chesterfield Drive. This project is part of Build NCC and will take approximately two years to complete.
