Schedule

Late August through Mid-September 2012

Benefits

- Improvements are planned on C Street between 3rd and 5th Avenues.
- New asphalt will replace worn pavement around tracks from 3rd to 5th Avenue.



New asphalt will replace worn pavement around tracks.

Station/Rider/Business Information

- The limits of work are as follows, from the easterly most pedestrian crossing at 3rd Avenue to the westerly most pedestrian crossing at 4th Avenue. The same limits apply from 4th to 5th Avenue. There is no work within the intersections, however there will be a lane closure on 4th Avenue.
- All work will be conducted between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.,
 Monday through Saturday. Limited Sunday work may occur.
- Noise and dust is anticipated during construction, especially during demolition of existing pavement.
- Pedestrian and service access to businesses and sidewalks will be maintained during construction.
- The Fifth Avenue and Civic Center Trolley Stations will remain open during construction.
- The schedule may change with very little notice.



The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. Beginning in September, the Green Line will be extended through Old Town to downtown and terminate at 12th & Imperial via bayside stations (Seaport Village, Convention Center and Gaslamp Quarter). Also beginning in September, the Orange Line will travel from El Cajon to Santa Fe Depot and the Blue Line will travel from San Ysidro to America Plaza. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
